HE MOVED TO PRINCE GEORGE TO WORK WITH BCTEL IN 1964 WITH HIS WIFE HELEN AND 3 YOUNGEST DAUGHTERS MEREDITH, BARBARA & JUDITH. HE BECAME A VALUED AND OUTSTANDING MEMBER OF OUR CONGREGATION WITH INVOLVEMENT ON THE DEACON'S BOARD, SUNDAY SCHOOL AND YOUTH. HE WROTE MANY PLAYS TO PRESENT THE GOSPEL IN A RELATIVE WAY TO OUR COMMUNITY WHICH WERE PERFORMED BY THE YOUTH. RON WAS AN EXCELLENT PREACHER AND OFTEN FILLED THE PULPIT.
